With only a two-and-a-half month window of ice-free ocean in the North, the Arctic summer is very short, but equally sweet. In September, the tundra is still clear of snow and ice, showcasing a surprising diversity of scenery, flora, and fauna. Small hotspots—sometimes literally microclimates—are set among the Arctic landscape. This time of year the sun does set in the evenings, so you may even see the mysterious green glow of the Northern Lights dancing overhead.

We start our journey in Canada's High Arctic archipelago, at one of Canada's northernmost communities. Featuring some of the most breathtaking scenery in the Arctic, we visit villages on the edge of massive fiords, glaciers thousands of years old, historic sites, and wildlife colonies.

TOWERING FIORDS, MAJESTIC ICEBERGS, BREATHTAKING ARCTIC SCENERY, INUIT CULTURE, CHANGES OF POLAR BEARS AND WHALES, ALL IN THE COMPANY OF DYNAMIC AND CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHER YOUNES BOUNHAR

Using our go-anywhere zodiacs, we explore this remote and exotic landscape. Our expedition team includes local Inuit, historians, marine biologists, and ornithologists who take us to historic and archaeological sites, wildlife colonies, and fascinating ice-worlds for an up-close experience. We do early morning and evening excursions that provide fantastic lighting opportunities: a photographer's dream. We visit Inuit villages where ancient traditions and modern way of life converge. Workshop leader and professional photographer Younes Bounhar will lead the group of photographers to help with shots and provide tips when needed. He'll do on-site demonstrations and evaluations and, while on ship, present lectures on different photo skills and themes, all intended to further develop participants' skills.
